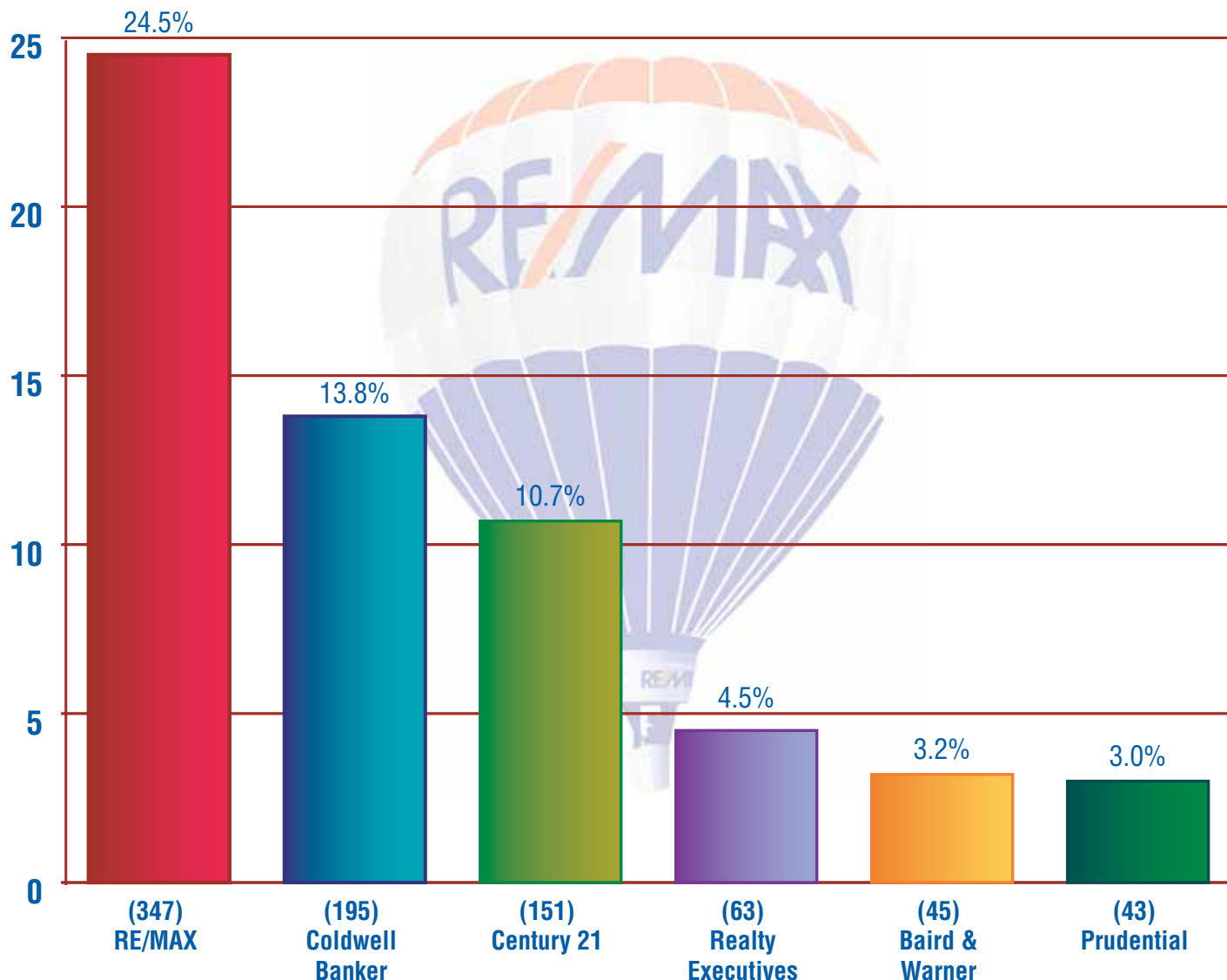


In the Southwest Suburbs,
